SCRUBLADE FOCUS GROUP TEST OVX-10

The test performed below was from "testers" with no connection or affiliate to Scrubblade LLC. Each "tester" was sent one Scrubblade wiper via UPS to each of their homes two weeks before the Overland Vehicle Expo. The object was to have each "tester" install a Scrubblade wiper on the driver side and a normal wiper on the passenger side. Each "tester" drove a minimum of 700 miles one way to the expo to test the claims stated by Scrubblade LLC and performance of Scrubblade wipers.

SCRUBLADE'S CLAIM - Scrubblade's patented, advanced dual-blade "Scrubber" technology utilizes hundreds of tiny triangular "scrubbers" on the leading edge of the two outer blades. The tip of each triangle pierces the debris and as it passes through and widens to the base, the triangle breaks it apart, literally "scrubbing" your windshield clean. The second "smooth blade" squeegees away any remaining debris or water left behind.

Testers have used initials for security purposes.

WHAT WAS YOUR GENERAL IMPRESSION OF THE SCRUBLADE?

T.D It's a good blade that does well against bugs and very well against dirt.

J.B. Interesting concept. Much promise.

J.F. Good

T.B. It cleared the windscreen of debris and water.

C.B. It appears to work very well removing bugs from the windshield. I was genuinely impressed with their performance the first time I used the blades on the highway, picking up bug debris for an hour. I had expected only a modest increase in performance over a traditional blade.

S.B. Noticeable difference between Scrubblade and regular blade, fewer bug splatters

D.B. Luke warm, it cleaned better than the Bosch I use, but not as good as a good hard scrub at the gas station

DaveB. Outstanding performance

D.C. Drivers side twice as clean as passengers

SPECIFIC LIKES:

T.D. Does a better job than a standard blade at scrubbing grime off the glass.

J.B. Easy installation. Appeared to somewhat reduce road debris compared to existing old windshield wiper.

J.F. It cleaned off the bugs better than an almost new Rain-X blade on the passenger side. Less "chatter" and squeaking than my Rain-X blade.

T.B. They seemed to clear insect debris more completely than a single blade.

C.B. It removed bugs from the windshield very well. With a moderate amount of windshield wiper fluid, the Scrubblade removed the majority of bug splatter, whereas the traditional wiper blade on the passenger side generally smeared the bug material over a greater area of the windshield. With judicious use of windshield wiper fluid, the Scrubblade would remove nearly all of the bug splatter, while the traditional blade would fail to remove much of the bug material around the point of impact, though it would generally remove the smeared area.

S.H. Windshield cleaner on Scrubblade side

D.B. Easy install, good fit and contour, no flutter.

DaveB. Removes dried bugs

D.C. Works as claimed

WHERE THERE ANY CONDITIONS WHERE THE BLADE PERFORMED EXTREMELY WELL?

T.D. Excellent on dirt roads. I ended up buying one for the rear glass on my Montero. This helped off-road as that vehicle tends to gather dust/ dirt on the back glass a lot more than the front.

J.B. Installation

J.F. Rain

T.B. During a thunderstorm in CO when hail was striking the windscreen it cleared the ice away far better than the other single-blade wiper. About 8 hours total were spent driving in light rain to thunderstorm conditions.

C.B. The Scrubblade works exceptionally in removing bug material from the windshield. The difference is night and day in this respect when compared to the traditional wiper blade.

S.H. Installation instructions on package need help. Once I opened the box and installed them it was straight forward

D.B. I was able to maintain safe visibility day and night using washers and blade.

DaveB. Long Road trip, mixed weather

D.C. When there were lots of bugs.

WHERE THERE ANY CONDITIONS WHERE THE BLADE PERFORMED VERY BADLY?

T.D. No

J.F. None

T.B. No

C.B. There were no conditions where I observed the blade performing badly.

The focus group is a group of people that are very particular about the products they use and put on there vehicles. They have given there honest opinions of how the Scrubblade performed during this test.

As you can see from the results above, Scrubblade wipers do exactly what we claim they do. This is a new technology that is needed in the automotive market as a must have safety and convenience item.
